

MAHARASHTRA STATE TABLE TENNIS ASSOCIATION

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS 2017-18

Purpose of the Regional Tournament

It is observed that players from the developing districts of Maharashtra do not participate in good numbers in the state ranking tournaments because of the growing disparity between their playing standard compared to that of the developed districts like MCD, MSD, Thane, Pune and Nagpur.

To provide an intermediate platform between district ranking and state ranking tournaments, the regional tournaments are planned, so that the players from developing districts will get to play, on a multi district platform, with the players who are more or less equal in the playing standard. This will encourage them to participate in this tournament and earn medals which are sure to boost their enthusiasm.

Considering the above purpose the regional tournaments are planned & the following rules and regulations are framed –

MCD, MSD, Thane, Pune and Nagpur being developed districts are excluded.

Name of the Tournament

The name of the tournament shall be termed as:

'Region Name' Regional Championships Table Tennis Tournament 20__.

In case of sponsorships or in case it is to be named after in any person the name will appear as under -

xxxxxx Memorial/xxxxxx Cup

Eligibility for participation

Players from the districts of the same region only can participate e.g. a player from Akola cannot participate in the North Maharashtra Regional Championships Tournament.

Player should not be ranked, in first sixteen, in any event of the state in current as well as two previous years cannot participate in the tournament.

Players from developed districts can not participate.

The age limit for the cadet, sub junior, junior and youth is as follows

e) YOUTH	Born on or after 01 – 01 – 1997

Date & Venue for the Tournament

The Dates of the tournament will be decided in Co-Ordination of Tournament Committee Chairman, MSTTA . The Venue will be finalized in joint Consultation of Tournament Committee, MSTTA and Regional Co- Ordinator.

Entries for the Tournament

- Entries will be submitted to the MSTTA Secretariat through the entry forms sent through email by the MSTTA.
- There will be no bar on the number of entries from any district.
- Entries will have to be submitted through District Secretaries only.
- In districts where affiliated associations do not exist, the players can give direct entries.

Seedings and Draws

The seeding committee for each regional tournament will be decided by the regional coordinator and will have representatives of at least 3 districts.

Based on the seedings provided by the regional seeding committee the draws & fixtures of the tournament will be processed at the MSTTA Secretariat.

Tournament Fee, Entry fee and MSTTA's Share

Entry fee will be Rs 150/- per event and will be collected by the organizer. 50% of the total entry fee shall be paid to the MSTTA against MSTTA's share in the entry fees. But those Host associations who are providing free lodging and boarding to all players they will have to pay only 20% of share in fees to MSTTA.

The tournament fee of Rs. 3000/- will have to be paid to MSTTA.

Prize Money and Points

The Prize money of Rs. 30,050/- will have to be paid to players as per the schedule attached.

Since the performance is not going to be counted for state ranking or selection, no points will be awarded.

Officiating

Tournament Committee Chairman will allot chief referee for the tournament. The umpires will be appointed by the organizer.

The Chief referee will be provided Lodging, Boarding, 2 way fare and honorarium of Rs. 3000/- by the Organizer.

The Umpires will be provided Lodging, Boarding, 2 way fare and honorarium of Rs.300/- per day, by the Organizer.

The MSTTA office bearers and Tournament committee will be provided Lodging, Boarding, 2 way fare by the organizer.

Responsibilities of the regional coordinator

- To promote the tournament in all the districts of the region and to ensure maximum participation.
- To appoint seeding committee and to convene its meeting.
- To ensure proper publicity for the tournament.
- To act as overall in charge of the tournament.

Responsibilities of the organizer

- To provide the venue with minimum 4 to 5 good quality table tennis tables.
- To ensure proper lighting arrangements and to provide generator backup wherever required to ensure uninterrupted play.

- To provide approved table tennis balls.
- To provide adequate number of umpires (in ratio of at least 2.5 per table).
- To distribute Prize Money as per the MSTTA format.
- To provide free accommodation to all outstation players.
- To provide all the assistance to the regional coordinator for seedings, press conference, promotion of the tournament in other districts etc.
- To collect Registration fee from the players, on behalf of the MSTTA, who are not registered with the MSTTA and deposit the same with the MSTTA Secretariat.
